The Keane OpenNotes Fellowship in Patient Engagement and Transparency is a Research Fellowship at the Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center. This is a non-ACGME funded fellowship program in Boston, Massachusetts. As part of the BIDMC Department of General Medicine and Primary Care, we invite you to apply for our two-year research fellowship to begin in July 2020.

This inaugural research fellowship is searching for postdoctoral candidates including physicians (all specialties), nurses, health behaviorists, sociologists, informaticists, and others with doctoral degrees who are interested in academic research careers with a focus on exploring how patient engagement and transparency can advance the quality, efficiency, and safety of health care.

Under the supervision of OpenNotes and other Harvard Medical School faculty, fellows will design, evaluate, and publish studies in these areas, thereby gaining the tools and credibility that will prepare them for successful careers.

The program offers candidates the opportunity to participate in the Summer Program in Clinical Effectiveness or/and a Master in Public Health degree at the Harvard T. H. Chan School of Public Health.
